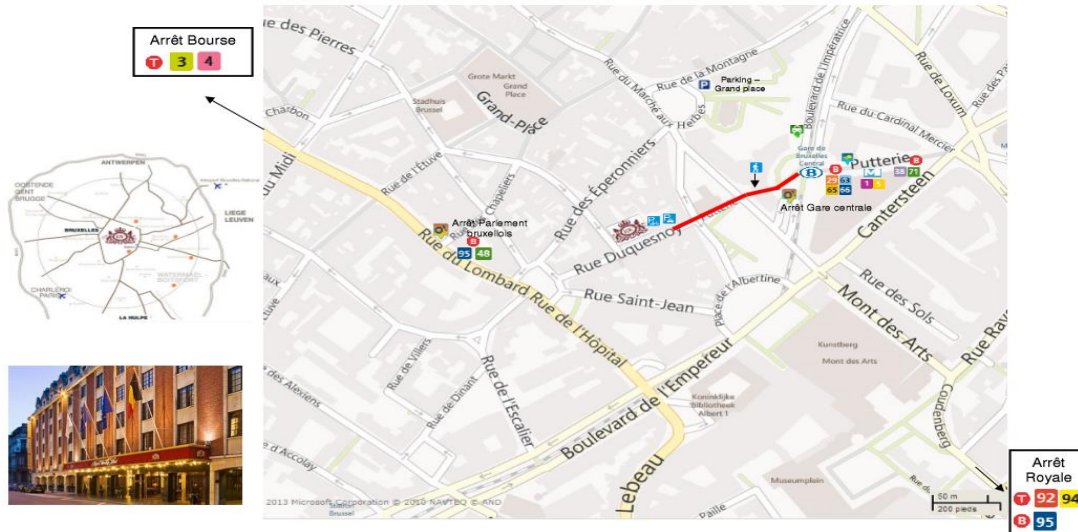

How to reach The Warwick Brussels

The Warwick Brussels is located in the heart of Brussels and easily accessible by car or public transports. Private parking is available at the hotel at additional cost.

Nearby Train Stations:

- Central Station: located a few steps from the hotel and offering, among others, direct connection to the South Station (Thalys, TGV and Eurostar terminals) and Brussels National Airport.
- South Station: Subway line 2 or 6 to "Arts-Loi" and change for the line 1 or 5 to Central Station.
- Brussels-Luxembourg Station: Bus 38 (Direction Debrouckère) to Central Station.
- North Station: Tram 3 or 4 (Direction Stalle) to Bourse (5 minutes by walk from the hotel.)

Airport: BRUXELLES ZAVENTEM (15.80 km)
