YOUNG RESEARCHERS/FUTURE INNOVATORS CONTRIBUTIONS

Young Researchers or EARPA members are invited to submit abstracts for innovative research topics in the context of the "**Transitioning Road Mobility: Actions to safeguard Europe's competitive edge**" in an elevator pitch of maximum 3 min. (3-4 slides). The elevator pitch should give a powerful overview of the research topic proposed. The ideas presented could be followed up within EARPA through Horizon Europe proposals, exchange of staff or other ways.

- a. Young Researcher/Future Innovator = PhD student, PostDocs with PhD obtained less than 2 years ago or junior researchers with less than 5 years working experience.
- b. The elevator pitches will be selected by an open call.
- c. The abstracts of the selected elevator pitches will be included in the FORM Forum proceedings. It will be published with the publisher SpringerBriefs by November 2025.

- Renewable energy for sustainable transport
- Software defined vehicle of the future
- Enhancing User Centricity, Safety and Accessibility through Digital Innovation in Mobility
- Competitiveness of circular solutions for EV and their components (End of life)
- Social acceptance of new mobility technologies, systems and services
- R&D and skills for European competitiveness
- Best practices for resilient value chain





SUBMISSION OF ELEVATOR PITCHES

Abstracts for Young Researchers/ Future innovators contributions should include the following information:

- (1) Title of the elevator pitch
- (2) Author(s) information (name, affiliation, address, e-mail, phone)
- (3) The contents of abstract will cover:
 - The objective (the problem to be solved)
 - The methodology
 - Potential impact
 - The applications
 - A description on how the research would appeal / influence government, industry and knowledge institutes.
- (4) 1 x A4 page
- (5) Font Arial 11, single line spacing
- (6) Official language: British-English
- (7) Use available template

Selected Young Researcher / Future Innovators will receive a $\frac{1}{2}$ day training on giving pitches the day before the FORM Forum 2025.
